The band is working on their song, but they need to figure out what rock music is all about.....

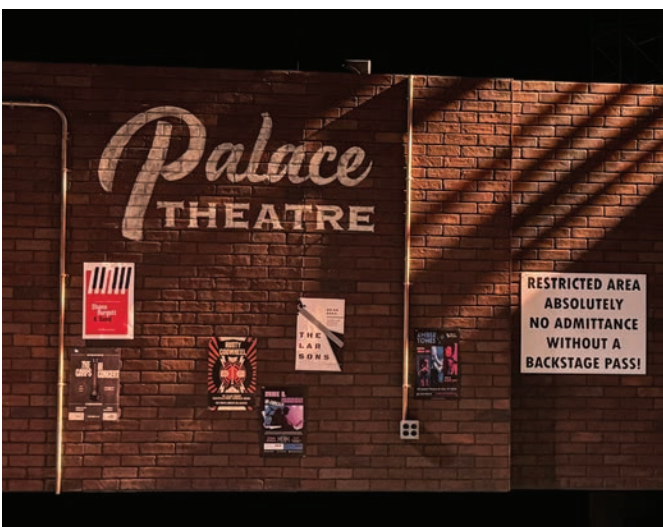




Oh no, is the "field trip" cancelled?

Patty is all the way over it, but how does Ned feel now?

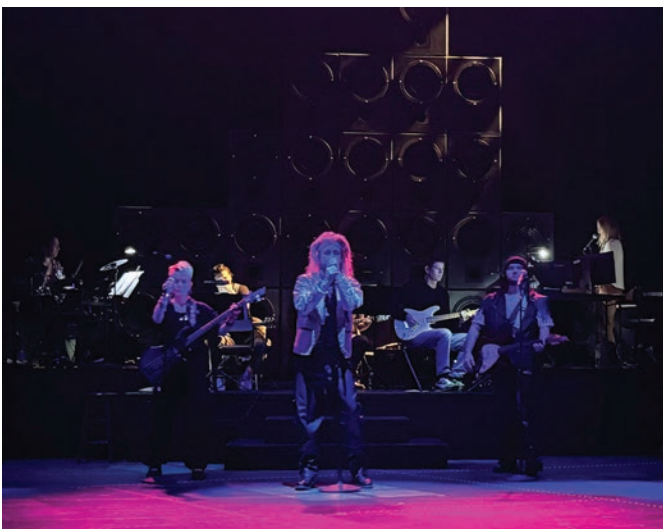




Dewey is shocked by these surprise visitors....
